

Malpractice Update: Carrier Concerns, Cybersecurity Threats, Starting a New Firm, Retiring from Practice

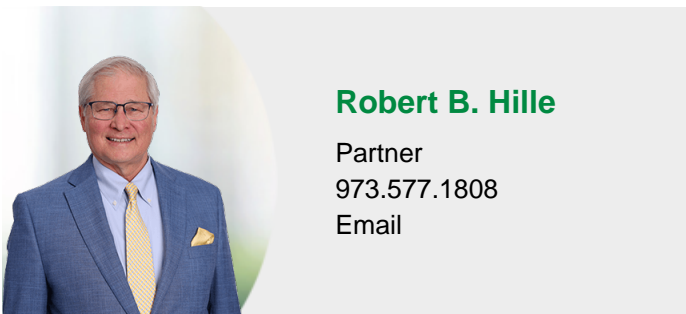
