

2023 Construction Law Forum

Steven Nudelman, Chair of the firm's **Construction Contracting & Risk Management** Practice Group, is a program co-coordinator and will lecture at the "2023 Construction Law Forum," to be presented in-person at the New Jersey Law Center on Wednesday, June 21, 2023 from 9:00am - 4:00pm. The program will also be broadcast as a live webinar. The full-day program will be hosted by the New Jersey Institute for Continuing Legal Education in cooperation with the NJSBA Construction Law Section. Mr. Nudelman is Immediate Past Co-Chair of the Section.

The 2023 Construction Law Forum will provide a day of in-depth analysis of some of the most common areas in construction law. Panelists will address a broad range of topics, including escalation clauses, Little Miller Act claims, contract termination, issues when representing the design professional, statute of repose, affidavit of merit issues, prompt payment, liquidated damages, tips for negotiating subcontracts, and special mediation segments on advanced mediation techniques, and ethical issues in construction mediation.

Mr. Nudelman, who will present a segment on "Liquidated Damages in New Jersey," is a partner in the firm's **Litigation** and **Real Estate** Departments, where he concentrates his practice in construction law. For over 25 years he has represented members of the construction industry across a broad spectrum of matters.
