

PFAS Update

David C. Scott, a partner in the firm's [Environmental](#) Department, will be a panelist for a presentation on the latest developments surrounding PFAS for the Associated General Contractors of America (AGC). The meeting will be hosted by the AGC's Environmental Steering Committee on Thursday, February 8, 2024, from 11:00am - 12:00pm at the AGC's headquarters in Arlington, VA.

The objective of this panel discussion is to provide meeting attendees with a better understanding of recent developments related to PFAS and their potential impact on the construction industry. Mr. Scott will focus primarily on the latest federal (EPA- RCRA/CERCLA) and various pending state regulations surrounding PFAS, including legal considerations related to real estate.
