Emily A. Kaller, a partner in the firm's **Litigation Department**, has been appointed Chair of the New Jersey State Bar Association (NJSBA) LGBTQ Rights Section. Ms. Kaller was sworn into her new role during the Bar's recent Annual Meeting and Convention in Atlantic City.

Ms. Kaller has long been a passionate and proactive advocate for the rights of underrepresented individuals. On assuming leadership of the LGBTQ Rights Section, she comments: "I am so proud to serve as Section Chair.
