

Jack Fersko Elected a Fellow of the American Bar Foundation

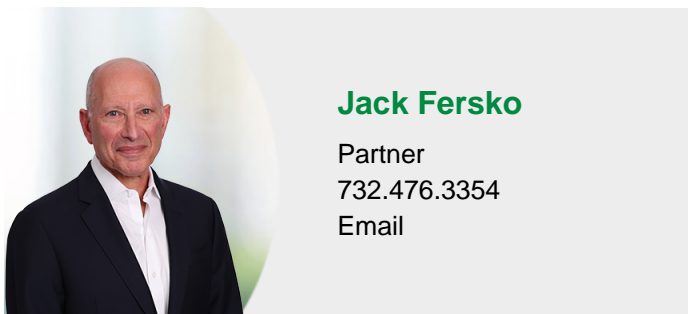
