

Navigating the New Normal: Today's Challenges for Consumer Bankruptcy Practitioners

Nancy Isaacson, a partner in the firm's [Bankruptcy & Financial Restructuring](#) practice, will lecture at the 2025 Honorable William H. Gindin Bankruptcy Bench Bar Conference, which will be held on Friday, May 2, 2025 from 8:00am - 4:00pm at the Palace at Somerset Park.
