

Pitfalls of Being an Operating Subchapter V Trustee

Nancy Isaacson, a partner in the firm's [Bankruptcy & Financial Restructuring](#) practice, will be a panelist at the National Association of Bankruptcy Trustees (NABT) 2025 Annual Conference, which will be held at the Phoenician Hotel in Scottsdale, AZ on June 1-4, 2025.

Nancy's program, titled "Pitfalls of Being an Operating Subchapter V Trustee," is scheduled for Tuesday, June 3 from 1:00pm - 2:00pm. The session will explore the challenges faced by Subchapter V trustees who assume control of a debtor's business.
