

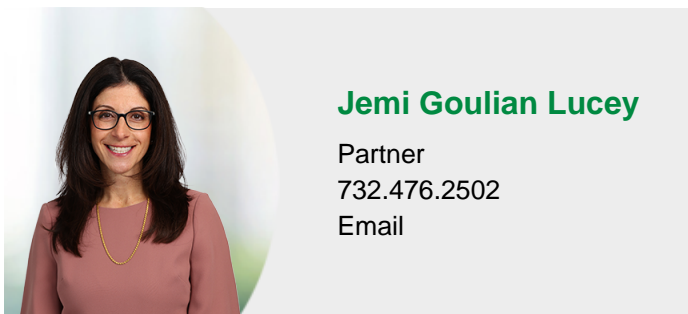
Pro Bono Practice and Your Career
