

What You Need to Know About Trust Accounting and Law Firm Planning

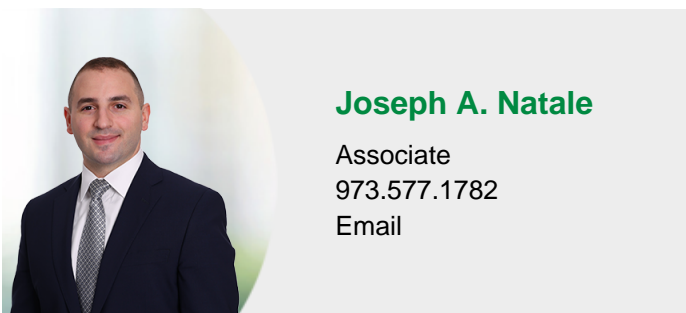
