

Voluntary Disclosures

Voluntary disclosure programs, both at the federal (Internal Revenue Service) and state (New Jersey Division of Taxation) levels, offer taxpayers the opportunity to proactively come forward and rectify past non-compliance before they are identified by tax authorities. When properly executed, a voluntary disclosure can significantly mitigate penalties, prevent criminal prosecution, and limit the look-back period for outstanding tax liabilities.
